

Figure S1: Multivariate Analysis of Clinical Variables and Objective Response to PD-1 Inhibition. Heatmap visualizes Pearson r values, with positive correlations depicted in blue, and negative correlations in red. Improved objective response was not significantly associated with any variables, but showed a trend towards significance with increased albumin ($p=0.052$).

Figure S2: Multivariate Analysis of Clinical Variables and Disease Control Rate with PD-1 Inhibition. Heatmap visualizes Pearson r values, with positive correlations depicted in blue, and negative correlations in red. Improved disease control rate was significantly associated with increased platelets ($p=0.035$), and all grade toxicity ($p=0.024$).
