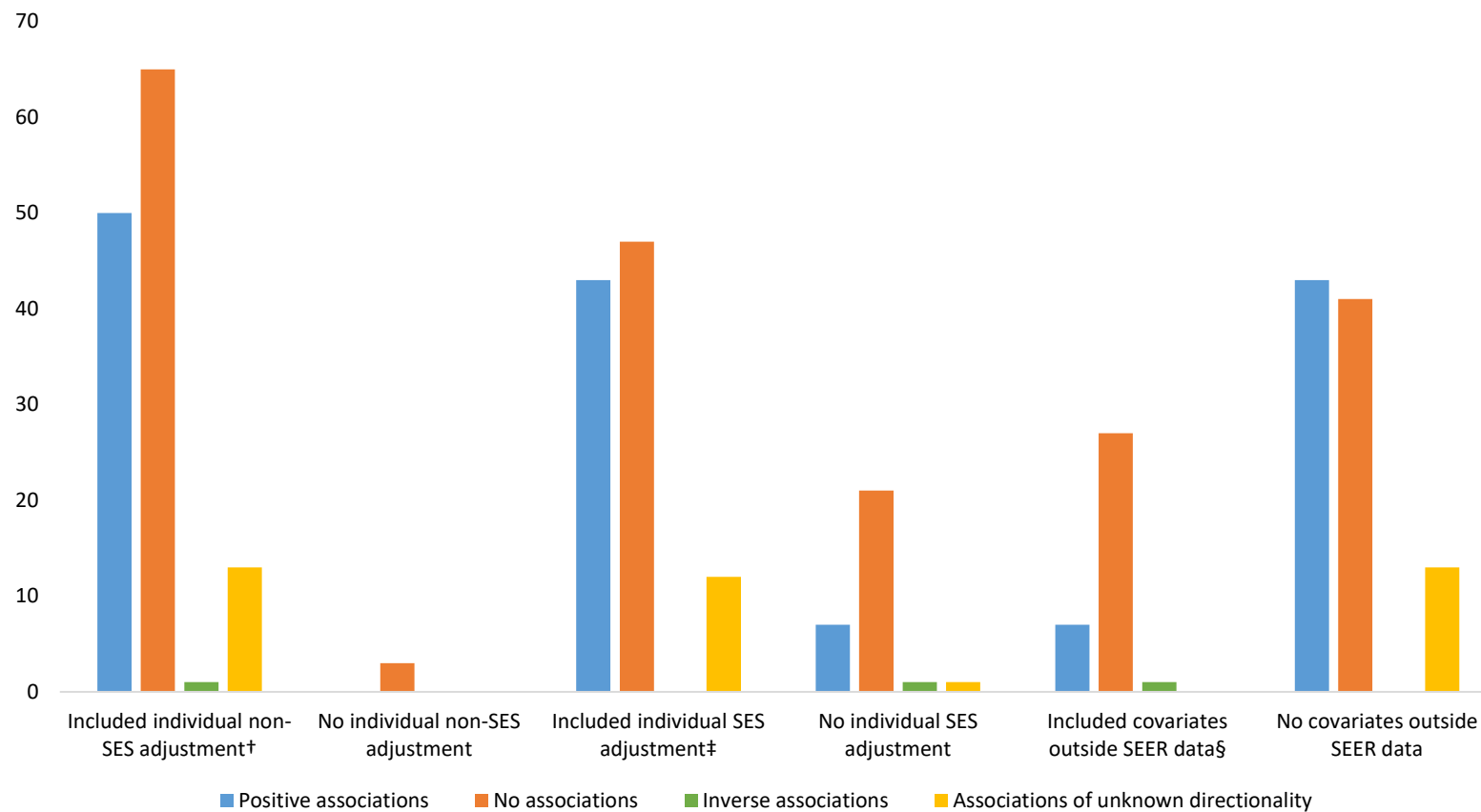


## Survival Associations Found in Studies With and Without Individual-Level Adjustments
