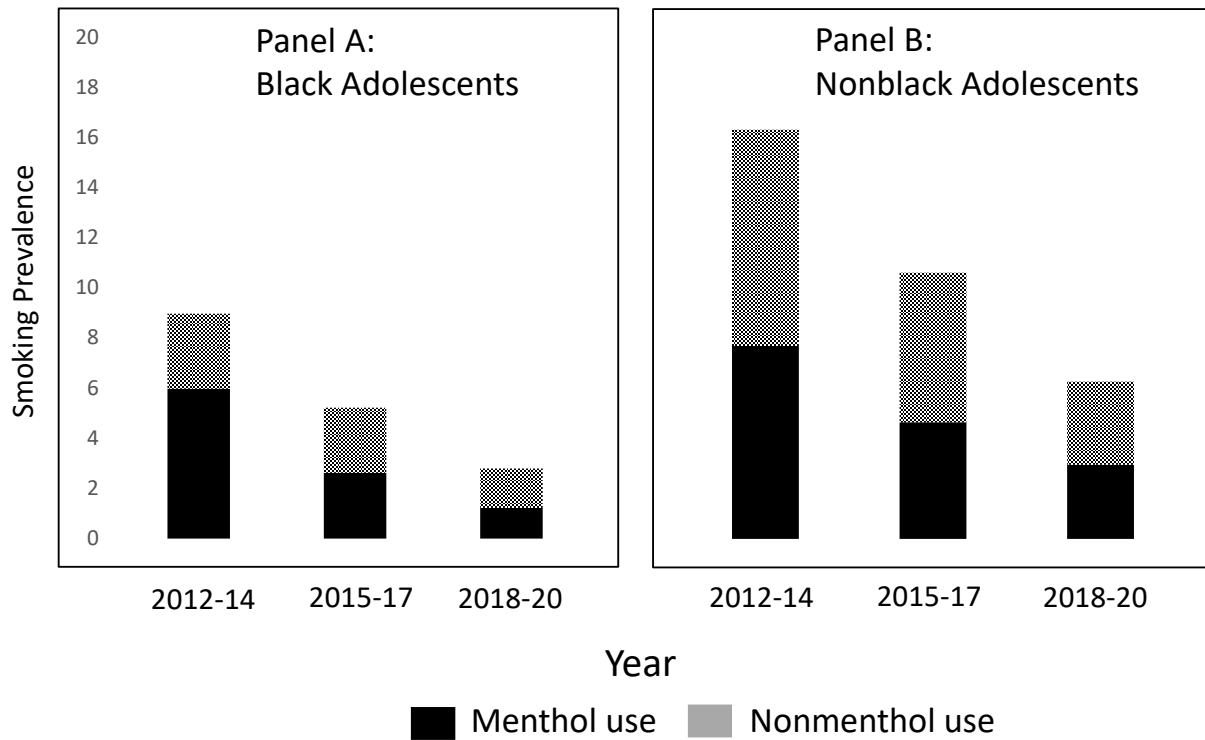


Figure S1: Prevalence of Past 30-Day Smoking by Menthol and Nonmenthol Use, Year, and Race for 12th Grade Students
