

There were 142 patients on the waiting list for atrial fibrillation (AF) ablation. We received 121 responses but excluded 3 patients as the quality of life (QoL) scores were incomplete. Of the 118 patients, priority categorization was available for 86 patients. There was a single patient categorized as C1 (urgent) with the remaining 85 patients in C2 (high priority) and C3 (routine) as demonstrated in the figure below.
