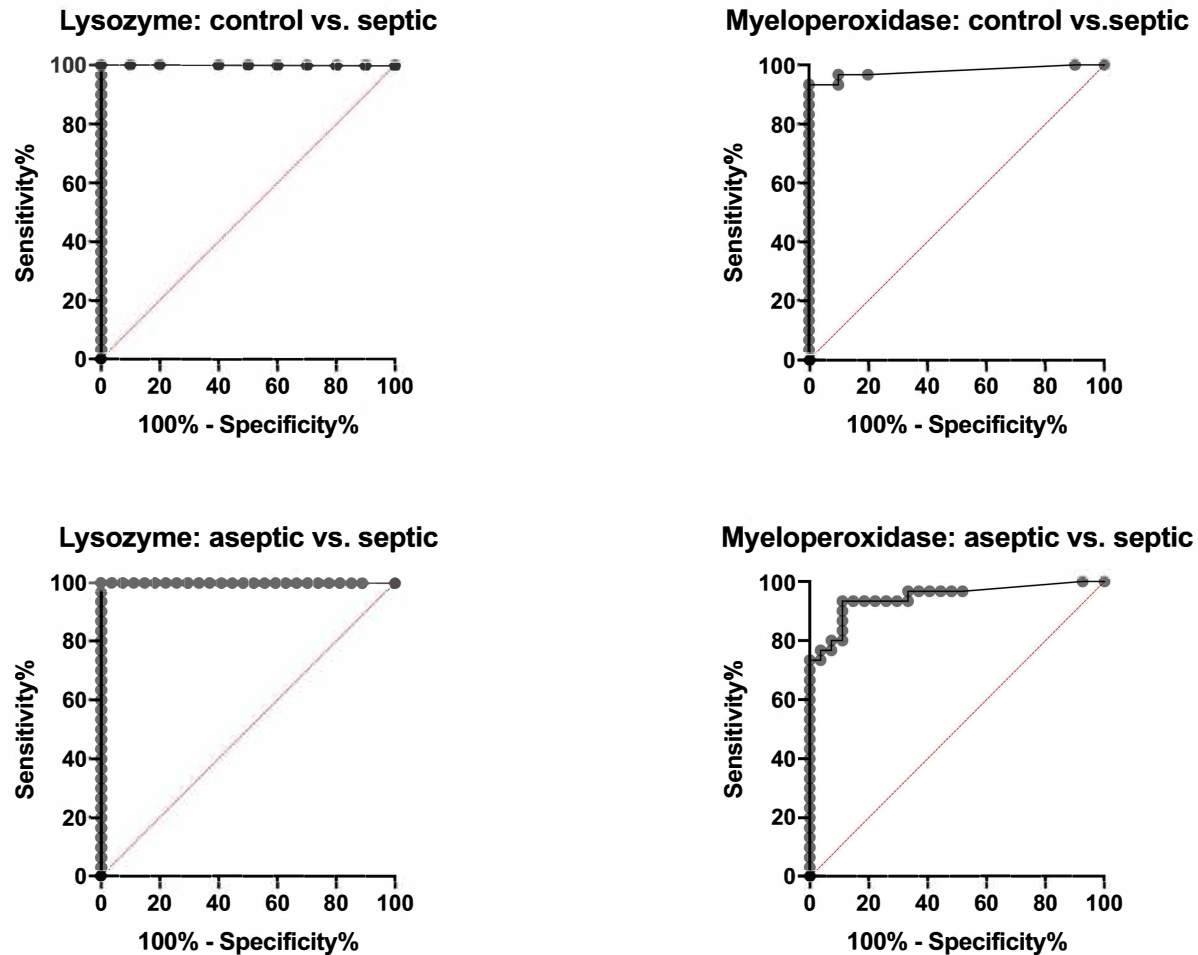
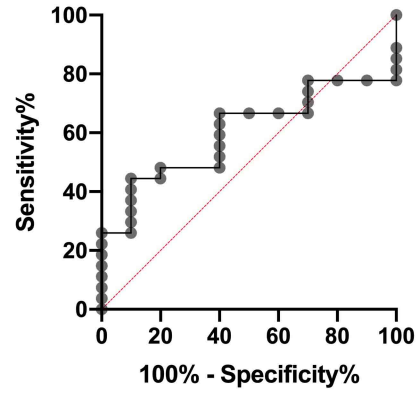


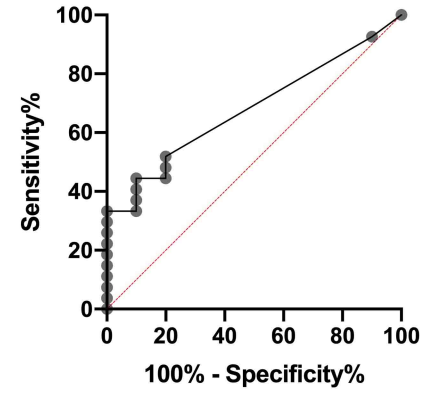

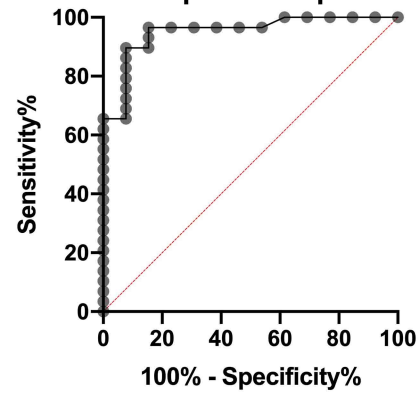
Lysozyme: control vs. aseptic
