- Medical Expert
 - 1. Integrate the CanMEDs Intrinsic Roles into their practice of medicine
 - 2. Recognize and respond to the complexity, uncertainty, and ambiguity inherent in medical practice
- Communicator
 - 1. Manage disagreements and emotionally charged conversations
- Leader
 - 1. Use health informatics to improve the quality of patient care and optimize patient safety
 - 2. Set priorities and manage time to integrate practice and personal life
 - 3. Manage a career and a practice
- Scholar
 - 1. Demonstrate a commitment to excellence in all aspects of practice
 - 2. Recognize the influence of role-modeling and the impact of the formal, informal, and hidden curriculum on learners
 - 3. Ensure patient safety is maintained when learners are involved

- 4. Assess and evaluate learners, teachers, and programs in an educationally appropriate manner
- 5. Recognize practice uncertainty and knowledge gaps in clinical and other professional encounters and generate focused questions that address them
- 6. Identify ethical principles for research and incorporate them into obtaining informed consent, considering potential harms and benefits, and considering vulnerable populations
- 7. Pose questions amenable to scholarly inquiry and select appropriate methods to address them

 - 2. Exhibit professional behaviours in the use of technology-enabled communication
