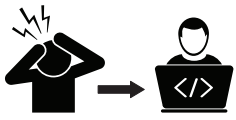


Potential Unmet Needs in Acute Treatment of Migraine in Japan: Results of the OVERCOME (Japan) Study

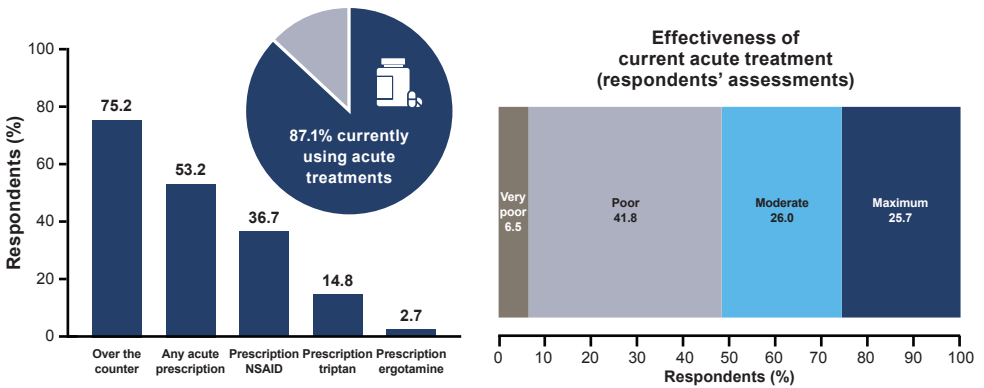
OVERCOME (Japan) was a cross-sectional, population-based web survey of people with migraine in Japan



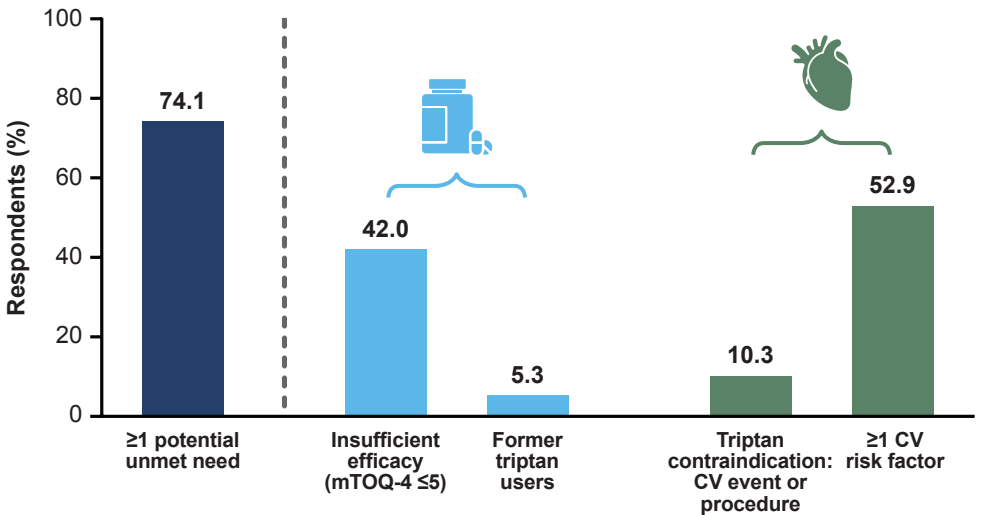
Survey questions included:

- Current acute medication use
- Medication effectiveness (mTOQ-4)
- Cardiovascular history and risk factors

17,071 people with migraine completed the survey



Potential unmet needs in acute treatment of migraine in Japan



74.1%

Nearly three-quarters of people with migraine in Japan may have potential unmet needs for acute treatment
