**Supplemental Methods** 

Codes used to identify TIA/AIS episodes

Diagnosis codes: ICD-9 codes (433.X (except for 433.10), 434.X, 435.X, 436.25), and ICD-10

codes (I63-I66 (except I65.2), I67.89, G45.X).

**Defining an episode** 

An episode included inpatient or outpatient ED/observation stays in any short-term acute care or

critical access hospital with a primary diagnosis for acute ischemic stroke (see "Codes used to

identify TIA/AIS episodes and neurology consultations"). For patients with multiple, contiguous

claims for stroke at the same hospital or across different hospitals, we consolidated their claim

records into a single episode. For example, if a patient with stroke was cared for in the ED of one

hospital, then transferred and admitted to another hospital, those different claims were combined

into a single admission episode that was classified based on the first hospital where they received

care.
